ADE Report

- The Strategic Plan committee is working hard. The mission will remain the same, but there will be a new vision. The objectives are still be finalized and drafted. Many of the current objectives have become institutionalized so we're looking to move forward and continue to improve.
- Two positions have been posted, but the Ed Rising opening is still on a hiring freeze.

ACTEAZ 22-23 Goals Update

A huge thank you to the ACTEAZ staff for continuing to move the goals forward.

- 1. <u>Develop a plan to increase vetted instructors based on research and identified need of</u> <u>Premier Series course by Summer 2023.</u>
 - a. **Update December 12**: Premier Series retreat was held to gain insights from current vetted instructions. New ideas were presented. The Premier Series committee that meets every other Monday, (Curt Bertelsen, Joel, Wakefield, Shelby Freytag, Jennifer Brooks, Susan Farretta, Kimberly McCroy and Shelly York) are in the process of coming up with some parameters for the vetting process and what is going to be needed. One of the items is that we feel we need to get CTE Director or Supervisor buy-in for a person to start the process. No additional progress on the development of electronic sign-in sheets and a digital survey. We are in the process of rethinking our format of our books and working with Premier Series Committee to see what we think as a group for going forward.
 - b. **Update February 1, 2023**: The Premier Series Group is still meeting and discussing the best way to do the vetting process, since all of us would like to use the same procedures. Premier Series Group are discussing creating a Focus Group with our CTE Directors and then will explain how the technology how it would work before they complete the Technology survey. This came out of the Premier Series meeting we had.
- 2. <u>Develop a monthly newsletter to all active members that highlight events and resources</u> <u>available to all member by the next fall retreat.</u>
 - a. **Update February 1, 2023**: Our second issue went out, December 2022 and the third issue in January 2023. This will be a monthly newsletter We believe this goal has been met and completed.
- 3. <u>Podcast repository: By end of 22/23 school year ACTEAZ will provide a minimum of four podcasts on relevant CTE related topics using ADE, board members, and lobbyists as sources. Track impressions and include on member survey.</u>
 - a. **Update December 12**: We have not started yet because of all the events going live and Premier Series classes in the last two months. We hope to start in January.
 - b. **Update February 1, 2023**: Alec and Shelly met, and have talked about ideas for the podcasts including:
 - i. Workforce Development
 - ii. Affiliates How to restart up
 - iii. Counseling
 - iv. Rural Areas
 - v. Summer Conference Presenters
- 4. <u>Provide teachers with exposure to their affiliates and provide opportunities for the</u> <u>Affiliates to network (measure by workshop/membership and attendance/members)</u>
 - Update December 12: Alec and Shelly are talking about offering sessions/activities at summer conference to bring affiliates together. Maybe a "What ACTEAZ can do for you! session."
